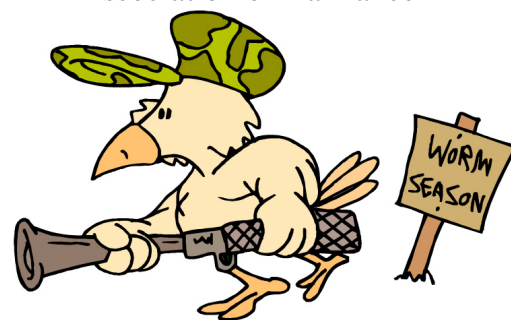

# THE 2009 SPORTING TRAP SHOOT CLASSIC RULES & REGULATIONS

NO ALCOHOL CAN BE BROUGHT INTO EXLINE SPORTSMAN CLUB PROPERTY-OR THEIR STAFF WILL ASK YOU TO LEAVE

NO ALCOHOL CAN BE CONSUMED WHILE YOU ARE PARTICIPATING IN THE TRAP SHOOT-. This is for your safety and the safety of all event participants.

FOID cards are not required to shoot a gun during this event. But if you own a gun that you are using during the event, it is recommended that have your FOID card with you.

## **EVENT SAFETY RULES:**

**When not actually standing in a designated shooting position, guns must be unloaded!** An unloaded gun is defined as having the breach open/exposed and the safety on. When riding on carts, guns must also be held and pointed straight up or straight down (even if the gun is in a case).

### **Placement of guns when not in use.**

**Eye/ear protection is required for all shooters.** It's also a good idea for spectators to have ear protection. Exline Sportsman Club will have earplugs available.

**Sporting trap stations will be scored on the "honor" system.** They will also require shooter volunteers to release the targets for each other if there is not a sponsor to do so at the station. Score cards will be provided. Ties will be broken by a score card play-off.

**DO NOT TOUCH/ADJUST THE CLUB'S EQUIPMENT!** The equipment is very expensive and can be extremely dangerous. The Club will have roaming personnel on the sporting clay fields to make corrections as needed should equipment jamb or malfunction. Please be patient if such a delay should occur.

**Prompt shooting is a must.** All side games and sporting trap areas will be very busy. Anything you can do to safely expedite the enjoyment for everyone around you will be appreciated.

**Be safety conscious!** Not all shooters are created equal. Do what you can to keep everyone around you safe.

**ANYONE CAN PARTICIPATE!! BEGINNING SHOOTERS ARE WELCOME!  
Guns will be available to borrow; however, you will have to purchase your own shells.**

**An instructional meeting is REQUIRED FOR ALL BEGINNER SHOOTERS prior to the event. This will take place at 1:00 p.m. immediately following registration.**

**Sporting Trap Shooters will have a safety meeting and briefing at 1:15 p.m. Please be on time so the shooting can begin promptly!**
